<p>Step 1: Read God's Word</p> <p>Look at the passage</p> <p>Matthew 28:18-20</p>	<p>Step 2: What Does God's Word Say?</p> <p>List the facts</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Re-read God's Word • List the outstanding facts with verse numbers • Do not paraphrase 	<p>Step 3: What Does God's Word Mean?</p> <p>Learn the lessons</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Write one spiritual lesson for each fact in Step 2 • Is there an example to follow, a command to obey, a warning to heed, a promise to claim? 	<p>Step 4: What Does God's Word Mean In My Life?</p> <p>Listen to His voice</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Put the lessons from Step 3 in the form of a question to ask yourself or someone else

And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."</p>	<p>v. 18 Then Jesus came and said,</p> <p>v. 18 All authority has been given to me</p> <p>v. 19 Therefore go,</p> <p>v. 19 Make disciples</p> <p>v. 19 Of all nations,</p> <p>v. 19 Baptizing them in the name of the Father, Son, Holy Spirit</p> <p>v. 20 Teaching them</p> <p>v. 20 To obey</p> <p>v. 20 Everything I have commanded</p> <p>v. 20 I am with you to the end of the age</p>	<p>v. 18 When we are in the place Jesus wants us to be, He will speak to us through His Word</p> <p>v. 18 His Word reveals there is nothing or no one beyond His power to control or command</p> <p>v. 19 Because Jesus is Lord we cannot be complacent, apathetic, stagnant, or uninvolved</p> <p>v. 19 It's not enough to share the Gospel, we must grow people up in faith</p> <p>v. 19 Faith in Jesus is not just for Americans, it's for everyone</p> <p>v. 19 We must saturate them in God's Word, lead them to full surrender</p> <p>v. 20 We are commanded to be actively involved in sharing God's Word</p> <p>v. 20 Obedience to God's Word is not optional</p> <p>v. 20 We are to teach the whole counsel of Scripture</p> <p>v. 20 There is no time or place that Jesus is not with us in this final hour!</p>	<p>v. 18 Am I where Jesus wants me to be?</p> <p>v. 18 If I am intimidated or frightened by those in authority, do I need to spend more time focused on Jesus in His Word?</p> <p>v. 19 What evidence of His Lordship is in my activity?</p> <p>v. 19 Have I stopped short of making disciples because I think evangelism of the world is the goal?</p> <p>v. 19 Why do I hesitate to share Jesus with someone of another culture, language, nationality?</p> <p>v. 19 Am I able to lead others to full surrender by my own example?</p> <p>v. 20 When was the last time I shared God's Word with someone else?</p> <p>v. 20 Can others look at me and see what it means to live by God's Word?</p> <p>v. 20 What parts of Scripture am I leaving out?</p> <p>v. 20 If I have Jesus, who or what else do I think I need to live in this final hour?</p>

Step 5: What Will I Do To Live Out God's Word?

Live in response: Because Jesus is my Lord, I will live for Him, tell others about Him, and help others to grow in their faith while relying on His presence in this final hour.
