- * **SPECIAL APPLICATION PROCESS AND/OR ATTENDANCE RESTRICTIONS:** Please see additional information found in specific descriptions below.
SEMINARS: Each Three- and four-day seminar begins with afternoon registration, a buffet dinner, and an evening session on the first day, and concludes prior to lunch on the final day. Seminar descriptions and scheduled worship leaders will be made available on-line or by phone.
- ^{ANW} **AN ASHEVILLE NIGHT OF WORSHIP:** A stirring evening of worship led by Asheville area worship leaders and musicians. This is a free program. An optional dinner is available (\$20), as well as overnight lodging at applicable rates.
- ^{CC} **CHRISTMAS AT THE COVE:** Three special evenings (December 2, 3 & 4) celebrating the birth of our Savior, begin with a gourmet dinner, followed by an evening program featuring BGEA music and program director Cliff Barrows and other special guests. Limited on-property lodging is available at applicable rates (please see below), which include breakfast the following day. See also December 17 & 18 for Christmas-themed dinner and concert evenings. (Open to youth as young as age 9 when accompanied by a parent or guardian.)
- ^{SO} **COME EARLY (^{CE}) AND STAY OVER (^{SO}) OPPORTUNITIES:** On selected dates (as noted), registered on-property inn guests (Shepherd's Inn/Pilgrims' Inn) may enjoy extended time away to rest, refresh, and refocus on God. Inn guests Come Early, arriving late afternoon one day prior to your event and/or Stay Over the night your event concludes, departing after breakfast the next day. Fees include meals and an evening devotional. **COST FOR EACH NIGHT YOU PARTICIPATE** is \$40 per person PLUS the cost of an additional night's lodging (see rates below). *Participation is limited to individuals with confirmed inn reservations for the course of their event and is subject to space availability. - ^{CSR} **CHURCH STAFF RETREAT:** Training/retreat opportunity for church and parachurch ministry teams begins with an afternoon session; concludes with lunch the next day. Solid biblical teaching combined with time for ministry team planning, prayer, interaction, and reflection. Stay Over opportunity can provide an extended retreat time.
- ^{EC} **AN EVENING AT THE COVE/CHRISTMAS AT THE COVE:** These inspiring evenings feature a gourmet dinner prepared by our world-class chef and an uplifting concert program with our guest artist(s). On-property lodging is available at applicable rates (see below) for those who would like to stay through breakfast the following day. (Open to youth as young as age 9 when accompanied by a parent or guardian.)
- ^{IBT} **INTENSIVE BIBLE TRAINING (IBT):** The IBT seminar is designed to take an intense and comprehensive approach to understanding a specific section of the Bible over the course of five days. The IBT begins with registration, dinner, and a teaching overview on Sunday evening. Teaching sessions start Monday morning and run through Thursday evening. The registration fee of \$455 includes all meals from dinner Sunday through breakfast Friday. Daily registration is available at \$147 per day, including meals and program fees (\$40 for Sunday evening program). Lodging is available at applicable rates.
- ^{LF} **LEADERSHIP FORUM:** The interactive workshop environment will enable participants to dialogue with a seasoned ministry veteran on a stated issue or topic for the purpose of character and ministry-skill development. Each mentoring opportunity will be limited to 30 individuals selected by application (available online or by request). Preference will be given to those with leadership responsibilities in church or parachurch ministries, and their spouses.
- ^{MMS} **MISSIONARY MEDICINE SEMINAR:** AMA PRA Category 1 CME credit available at this optional seminar. (See also Come Early option October 6.)
- ^{PI} **PASTORS' INSTITUTE:** Uplifting and restoring, each one-day institute is designed to encourage pastors (and spouses) and their ministry teams. Morning and afternoon sessions, materials, and lunch are included. Cost: \$63 per person for pastor/team member (\$94 for pastor and spouse).
- ^{PR} **PRESCRIPTION FOR RENEWAL:** A relaxing and renewing weekend of fellowship, testimonies, and Bible teaching tailored for Christian physicians, dentists, and medical professionals interested in the mission field. Spouses are also welcome.
- ^{RRT} **CHAPLAIN TRAINING CONFERENCE:** The Billy Graham Rapid Response Team (RRT) offers this four-day seminar for pastors, church leaders, chaplains, and anyone interested in crisis relief ministry. Learn to effectively share God's love and His Word with those experiencing trauma in times of disaster. Learn about our chaplain ministry and how to join us in future deployments to disaster areas while completing an International Critical Incident Stress Foundation course. Rates and additional information available online or by phone.
- ^{SR} **SENIORCELEBRATION:** Each *SeniorCelebration* will address the specific concerns of seniors today with special workshops and teaching from God's Word to help you learn to live for Christ and share Him with others. Restful and inspiring! (Open to all, but designed for ages 55 and up.)
- ^{SS} **SENIORSALT EVENTS** are open to all but designed to be enjoyed by groups, couples and individuals ages 55 and up. SENIORSALT IMPACT programs are designed to encourage believers to better influence others for Christ through the showing of a Christian movie from BGEA's Worldwide Pictures, followed by a Cove Staff-led life application discussion. Morning programs conclude with a buffet-style lunch. Evening programs begin with a buffet-style dinner and offer an optional overnight lodging stay at applicable rates. SENIORSALT HYMN SINGS and CAROL SINGS are morning events that include lunch.
- ^{WBS} **WOMEN'S BIBLE STUDY:** These FREE Bible studies are open to area women. The studies meet each Tuesday (possible exceptions), and offer corporate praise and worship, Bible teaching, and guided independent study. New participants and visitors are always welcome. The Tuesday morning study offers an optional lunch (\$6, prepayment is required) and small group opportunities. Lodging is not available in conjunction with these studies.
- ^{WS} **WORSHIP SEMINAR:** This seminar is designed to enrich the ministry of worship team members. It is open to active worship pastors, worship leaders, and worship team members. Senior pastor (and his or her spouse) may also attend. Additional requirements and restrictions are detailed on the registration form (available online or by request). As space is limited, spouses other than pastor's spouse, are invited only if they are part of the worship team.

ADVANCE PAYMENT AND DEPOSIT REQUIREMENTS

Each reservation must be accompanied by a deposit of \$75* per person, per event. **Any remaining program and lodging fees** may also be paid at that time and **must be paid in full no less than 30 days prior to your scheduled arrival**. Failure to prepay 30 days in advance will result in the loss of your deposit and cancellation of your program/lodging space. Most cancellation requests received prior to the 30-day deadline are eligible for a full refund (exceptions noted below*). A refund of payments received, less your deposit, may be requested up to two weeks prior to your arrival. No refunds will be made less than two weeks prior to the event; however, monies paid may be transferred to another event in the same or following calendar year. Lodging accommodations in our inns and participation in our Come Early/Stay Over opportunities are subject to space availability.

*An Evening at The Cove, Christmas at The Cove, SeniorSalt events, and Pastors' Institutes require an advance deposit equal to the cost of the event. Deposits are non-refundable; however, if cancellation is made at least 30 days in advance, monies paid may be transferred to another event in the same or following calendar year. A lodging deposit, where applicable, is also required.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

All programs, meeting facilities, and lodging accommodations are open to adults, ages 18 and over, and to youth ages 15-17 when accompanied by an adult.
